- Ensure that equipment and the facility are clean, well-maintained, and safe at all times.
- Build relationships with the children, youth, and families within their designated programs. Establishes open communication with parents/caregivers.
- Use Club vans to pick up members from school and transport to various sites if required.
- Prepares nutritious snacks and meals for members
- Mentors, guides and leads activity leaders with the program and program activities.
- Provides group and/or individual behaviour management and support.
- Ensures Agency Policies and Procedures, Program Operating Standards, WCB standards, Community Care Licensing Regulations, Risk Management requirements and general safety standards are met.

- A diploma or degree in recreation and/or experience planning, implementing and evaluating recreation programs for children.
